

**RESOLUTION NO. 18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE VAIL TOWN COUNCIL EXTENDING THE
DECLARATION OF A LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, the Governor of the State of Colorado recognized the COVID-19 pandemic and declared a state of emergency;

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the Town Manager declared a disaster emergency in and for the Town of Vail, Colorado, pursuant to the Colorado Disaster Emergency Act, C.R.S. § 24-33.5-701, *et seq.* (the "Act"), and Section 13.5 of the Town's Home Rule Charter;

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Town Council ratified the Town Manager's Declaration and extended it for 30 days;

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2020, the Town Council extended the Town Manager's Declaration to May 5, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the emergency conditions caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, as defined by C.R.S. § 24-33.5-702 and the Charter, persist and require additional and sustained action by the Town.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF VAIL:**

Section 1. The Declaration of a Disaster Emergency in and for the Town of Vail, a copy of which is attached, is hereby extended to June 2, 2020.
