

RESOLUTION NO. 21, Series of 2022

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF VAIL AND THE
STATE OF COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES FOR CO-RESPONDER
MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES**

WHEREAS, The Co-Responder model was developed to link people with mental illnesses to appropriate services or to provide other effective responses by partnering specifically trained officers with mental health professionals to provide a joint, secondary response to a necessary situation; and

WHEREAS, The Town wishes to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Colorado Department of Human Services for the provision of Co-Responder services pursuant to the terms of the Department of Human Services Contract (the "Contract") attached hereto as **Exhibit A**,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VAIL, COLORADO THAT:

Section 1. The Town Council hereby approves the Contract and authorizes the Town Manager to enter into the Contract on behalf of the Town in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit A and in a form approved by the Town Attorney.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
