

RESOLUTION NO. 21

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TIMBER SALE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF VAIL AND THE UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE; AND SETTING FORTH DETAILS IN REGARD THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Town of Vail (the "Town"), in the County of Eagle and State of Colorado is a home rule municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Colorado and the Town Charter (the "Charter");

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council of the Town (the "Council") have been duly elected and qualified;

WHEREAS, for the past 4 years the Town and U.S. Forest Service (the "USFS") have been working together to develop and implement the Intermountain Fuels and Forest Health project (the "Project");

WHEREAS, because, as part of the Project, the helicopter logging treatment area is on USFS land, the USFS must transfer the responsibility for treatment over to the Town. The process chosen to transfer this responsibility was through the use of a timber sale agreement (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Agreement spells out the Town's responsibilities for the completion of the Project area in compliance with the environmental review that was completed in 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF VAIL, COLORADO THAT:

1. The Agreement is hereby approved in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit A** and in a form approved by the Town Attorney.
2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
